NREN roles and strategies

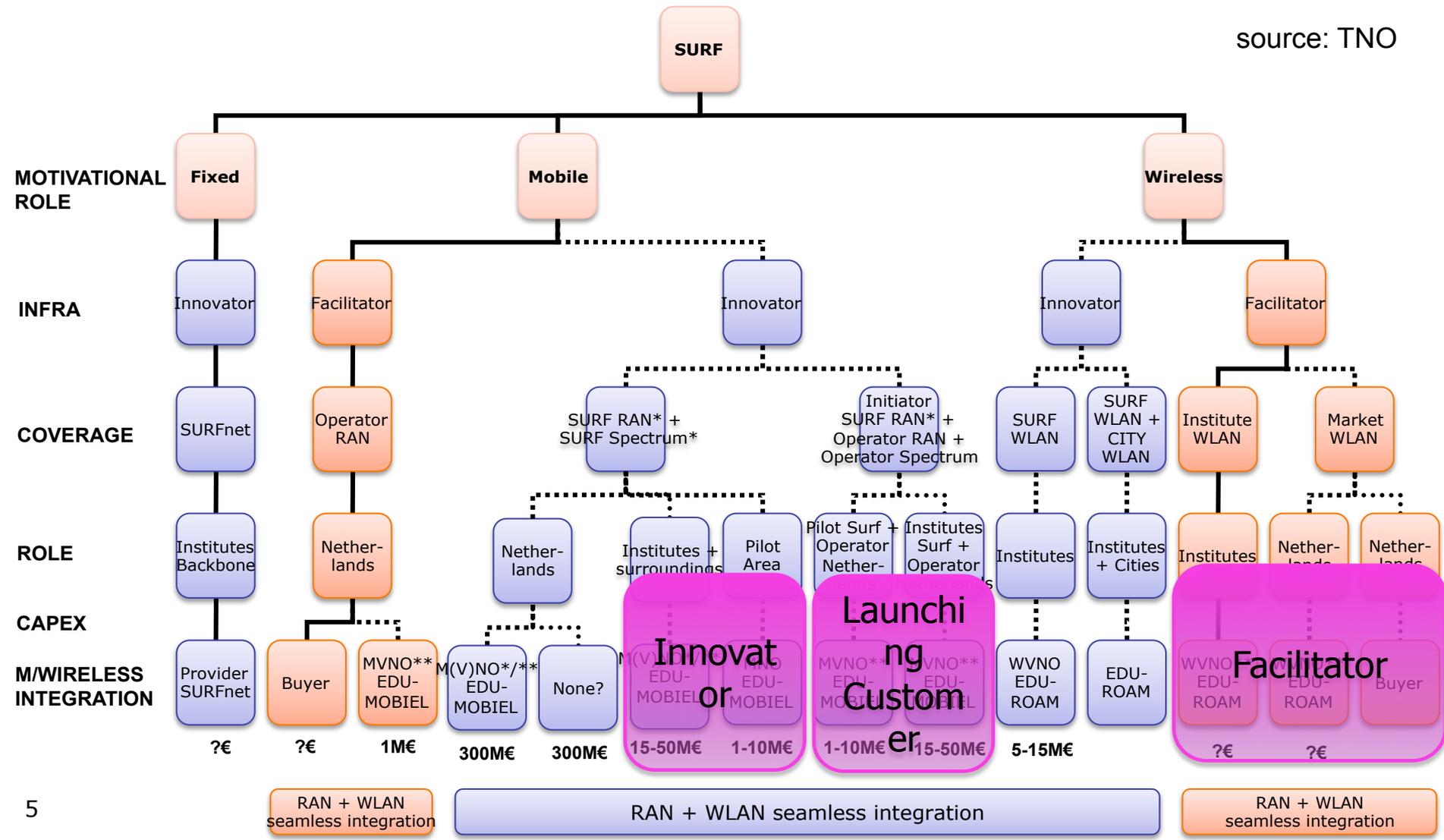


- SURFnet asked TNO research to investigate options, impact
- 3 possible strategies, examples
 - **Innovator**
 - Have own spectrum, production, experiment?
 - Can we be our own mobile operator?
How to deal with users? Are we interesting?
(Cheap? Latest iPhone?)
 - **Launching Customer**
 - Collaborate with existing mobile operators? MVNO?
Cheap offerings, offload traffic?
 - **Facilitator**
 - eduroam coverage in cities,
work with commercial hotspot providers?
 - **Trusted advisor?**

Issues



- **Legal issues**
 - Can we use our IP-space via a commercial provider? (Closed user-group.)
 - What about using the spectrum of providers?
- **Being ambitious can be costly**
 - National (3G/4G/...) coverage?
 - Small coverage, own spectrum could be enough for experiments and innovation, but what does that give us? (Happy users?)
- Showing that emerging technologies (like LTE) work are more trivial than **making seamless roaming work.**
